Some unintended errors regarding the Wolk en Water Hermitage in the article 'Visiting the Dutch OBC Temples' have been brought to the author's attention. The following provides the necessary corrections.

The purchase of suitable premises for the Wolk en Water Hermitage in Langelille was funded by the proceeds from the sale of the former home of Reverend Master Hakuun's parents in Amsterdam. The temple is located in the Dutch province of Friesland, a rural location surrounded by fields, nearby canals and wide views. It is quiet and peaceful in the countryside with a place for meditation (the Zendo) and facilities, including residential rooms, for retreats (the hermitage).

A regular programme of weekly meditation sessions as well as daily and multi-day retreats are available. It is also possible to make longer, individual retreats in consultation with the resident monk, Reverend Hakuun.

The Sangha member, Elizabeth, is in fact Dutch but worked for some years in both England and Scotland.
